Stephanie Flowers for Atlanta (“we,” “our,” or “the Campaign”) is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, how we use it, and how we safeguard it when you visit our website or interact with the Campaign online.

I. Information We Collect

When you interact with our campaign, we may collect:

- **Personal Information:**
This includes things you voluntarily give us, such as your name, email address, phone number, mailing address, payment/donation information, and any other information you choose to provide.
 - **Non-Personal/Automatically Collected Information:**
Details that do not directly identify you, such as your IP address, browser type, device type, pages visited, time on page, and other site usage metrics.
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II. How We Use Your Information

We use the collected information for purposes including but not limited to:

- Communicating campaign updates, events, volunteer opportunities, and news.
 - Processing donations and fulfilling financial/legal obligations under campaign finance laws.
 - Improving website functionality and user experience.
 - Responding to inquiries or requests you submit.
 - Meeting legal, regulatory, or compliance requirements.
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III. How We Share Your Information

We do **not** sell, rent, or trade your personal information. We may share information only in the following limited cases:

- **Service Providers:** Third-party vendors who help us with payment processing, email and communications, website analytics, or other functions. These parties are required to handle your information securely.
 - **Legal Requirements:** If required by law, court order, or to comply with government requests, or to protect our rights or safety.
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IV. Cookies & Tracking Technologies

- We may use cookies, web beacons, tracking pixels, and similar technologies to understand website usage, improve site performance, and deliver a better user experience.
 - You can disable or block cookies in your browser, though this may impact certain features of the website.
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V. Data Security

- We employ reasonable administrative, technical, and physical measures to safeguard your personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.
- Despite our efforts, no system or method is completely secure. We cannot guarantee absolute security.
